

Dr. Roli Misra is a Professor of Economics at the University of Lucknow with over 23 years of teaching and research experience. She holds an M.A. and Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Lucknow and specializes in agricultural economics, gender studies, migration, population studies and development economics. Her research focuses on gender disparities, gender budgeting, migration, public distribution systems, demographic transitions, rural livelihoods and socio-economic development in Uttar Pradesh and other regions of India.

Prof. Misra has published extensively in reputed national and international journals, including Economic & Political Weekly (EPW), Millennial Asia, The Indian Journal of Labour Economics, Journal of Social and Economic Development, International Studies, Demography India, Yojana and Productivity by National Productivity Council of India. She has also authored and edited books published by PHI, Sage and Rawat Publications.

She has received several prestigious awards, including the Dr. K. Srinivasan Award from the Indian Association of Population Studies and the Femina Spark Mission Shakti Award for her contributions to gender empowerment. She has successfully led research projects funded by NCW, ICSSR, UGC, Oxfam India, PLAN India and NECTAR, New Delhi.

Prof. Misra has presented papers at international conferences organized by IUSSP, PAA, and APA across countries such as the USA, China, Indonesia, Slovenia, Mauritius, and Sri Lanka. She currently serves as Convenor of the Gender Sensitisation Committee at the University of Lucknow and is empanelled as a Gender Expert with the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad.
