

Dr Tejinder Kaur is working as Professor of English at RIMT University, Mandi Gobindgarh (Punjab). Earlier, she served as a Professor of English at Punjabi University, Patiala and held the positions of Head, Department of Distance Education, Dean, Faculty of Languages, Director, Centre for Diaspora Studies and Co-ordinator IGNOU, New Delhi Study Centre, Patiala. She is also a Professor of English on an honorary basis in the School of Languages of Jagat Guru Nanak Dev Punjab State Open University, Patiala. She has more than 43 years of teaching experience and 38 years of research experience. She has written/edited/co-edited 12 books, including her three books of poems. She has published more than 70 research papers/book reviews/ review articles/Forewords in various national and international journals, Conference Proceedings and anthologies. She has participated in more than 180 national and international conferences, webinars, workshops, etc. and has made presentations in various capacities and chaired many sessions. She has also delivered more than 175 extension lectures as a resource person in different universities and colleges and on various other forums. She has also given lectures in Edusat programmes of Haryana and has been on AIR Jalandhar and Patiala, and Jalandhar Doordarshan, delivering talks on many topics and presenting poetry readings. Her poems have been included in a few World Poetry collections, journals and anthologies. She has also been felicitated with a few poetry awards. She has been interviewed by a YouTube Channel for highlighting different aspects related to the Punjabi Diaspora. She has organised more than 35 National and International Conferences, workshops, interviews, lectures on different subjects and has been associated with Sahitya Academy, New Delhi and Department of Punjabi Development, Punjabi University, Patiala, in many translation projects. She has been on various panels of advisory committees of Literary journals, Public Service Commissions, Boards of Studies of many colleges and Universities, as an outside expert on different committees of many Universities, including review and selection Committees. More than 43 M.Phil and 17 PhD candidates of Punjabi University, Patiala, and RIMT University have completed their Research theses on different areas under her supervision. Nine PhD candidates of RIMT are in the process of pursuing their Research under her guidance. Moreover, she has examined the theses and conducted viva of more than 150 M.Phil and PhD candidates of about 30 universities. Dr Tejinder Kaur's scholarship, creativity, and leadership in the field of English Studies and Diaspora Studies have made her a distinguished academic and respected voice in literature and higher education.
